ADDENDUM OF OCTOBER 1, 2014

As stated in the HUD CoC Notice of Funding Opportunity and the TA materials distributed by HomeBase, one of the possible sources of new funding this year is through reallocation. This is not a guaranteed source of funding, but can become available if the Review and Rank Panel decides to reallocate funding or if a renewal project voluntarily decides not to apply.

We have been notified that a renewal project will not be reapplying this year. Therefore, please be advised that there will be a minimum of \$140,000 of reallocated funding available. These funds will be distributed through the Review and Rank process, as described in the TA Local Competition Handbook, page 5. These funds can be used for new permanent supportive housing for chronically homeless individuals or families OR for new rapid rehousing projects for homeless households with children coming directly from streets or emergency shelter.
